A full hot/cold breakfast buffet will greet you on Saturday and Sunday morning before our daytime sessions commence. We will begin our Saturday session in a beautiful way by beginning together in faith with the celebration of Mass at 8:15am. Our vendors will be setup and ready bright and early Saturday morning until 5:30pm.

A wonderfully enriching weekend awaits with a beautiful closing Mass at 3pm on Sunday, June 1, 2025, at St. Andrew's Church in Oakville, which is one of our diocesan designated Holy Doors for the Jubilee Year of Hope. We will return to the hotel for a cocktail hour and a Gala Banquet with presentations and awards.

We're pleased to host our convention in a **newly renovated** hotel with **pre-COVID discounted rates** for accommodations, meals, and facilities. Please register and book your rooms early to avoid disappointment.
